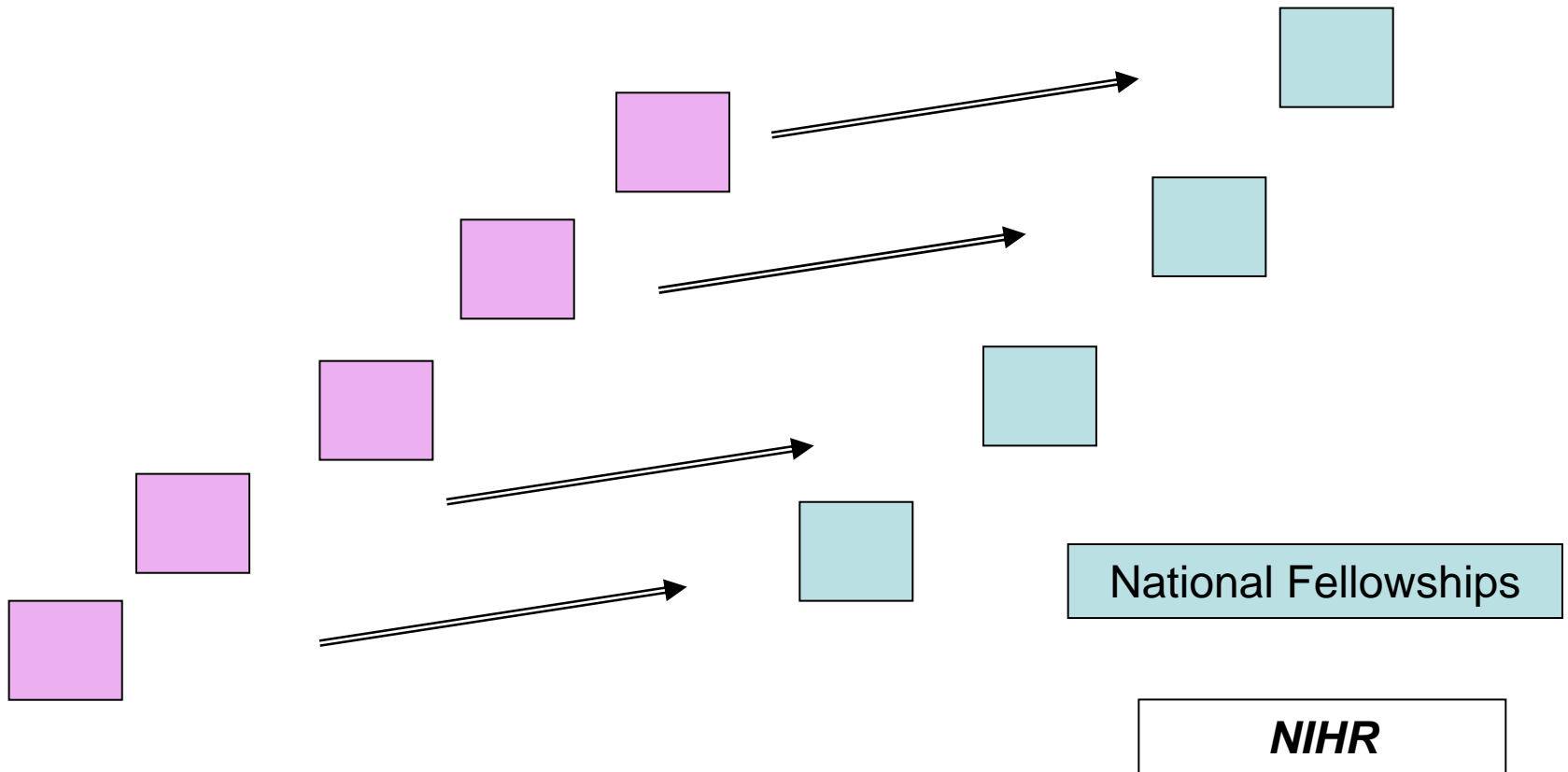

WM NMAHP Research Training Awards

- Research Training Support Award (pre-PhD)
- Research Training Fellowship (PhD)
- PhD Completion Award (PhD)
- Bridging Award (post-PhD)
- Clinical Lectureship (postdoctoral)

WM NMAHP Research Training Awards

- Core eligibility requirements
- Graduate (or equivalent) nurse, midwife or allied health professional
- Undertake research training in WM university
- Clinical element undertaken in WM (NHS organisation)

WM NMAHP Research Training Support Award

- Flexible 12-24 months
- Develop research skills and PhD project

WM NMAHP Research Training Fellowship

- Support for PhD
- Requirement to have made application to national scheme

WM NMAHP PhD Completion Award

- Individuals who have completed 2 years of research towards PhD and are combining research and clinical work
- Up to 12 months salary funding to fast-track completion of PhD

WM NMAHP Bridging Award

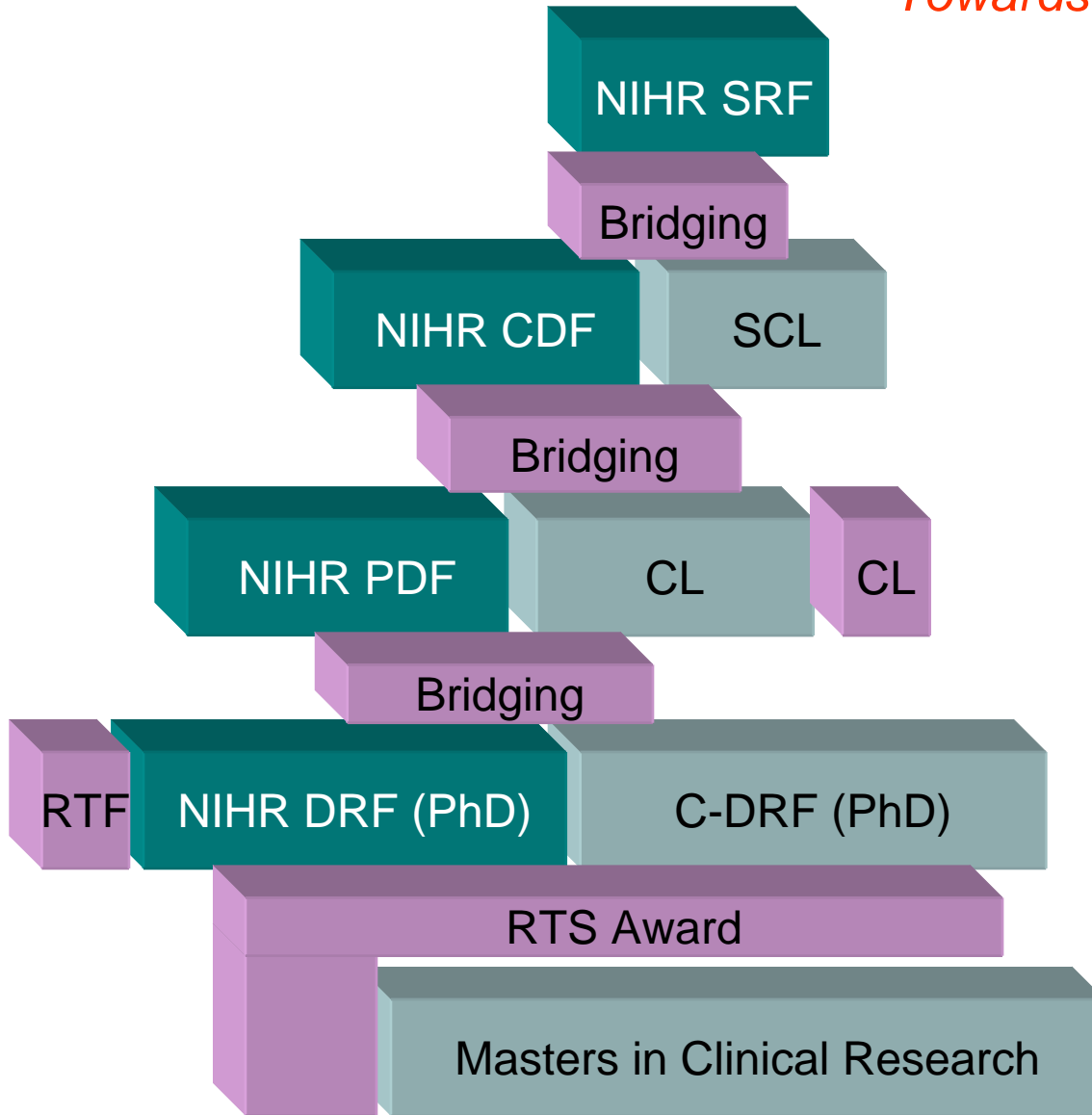
- Up to 12 months salary funding for those awaiting next national fellowship application
- Avoids need to find alternative employment

WM NMAHP Clinical Lectureship

- 48 months of postdoctoral research training
- Combined with clinical commitment
- 50:50 research:clinical
- Requirement to have made application to national scheme
